09.45 am	Departure to Het Openluchtmuseum, an open air museum, by bus
11.00 am	Guided tour: A walk through the past
00.00 pm	Departure to Pannenkoekenhuis Den Strooper, an authentic Dutch restaurant, by bus
00.15 pm	Lunch, eating 'pannenkoeken', a real Dutch treat

It's possible to be brought back to the DAC or to the railway station after the lunch if you have to catch a plane or train.

01.30 pm

Across the street is the entrance of “Nationaal Park De Hoge veluwe”, a beautiful nature reserve. In the park there are several options you can choose from:

- Museum of art Kröller Müller
- Museum of the Dutch ecological system, Museonder
- Beeldentuin, a big garden with art and statues
- Jachtslo St. Hubertus, a hunting castle
- The nature reserve itself

At several cycle stores in the park one can borrow a white bike (for free). You use them to travel from one point to the other. After use you can leave the bike at the nearest cycle store.

04.30 pm

Departure back to the DAC. It's also possible to be dropped off at the railway station.
