**Invitation to the fifth project meeting  
in Győr (Hungary)  
from December 11<sup>th</sup> – December 14<sup>th</sup> 2008**

Dear Colleagues,

This is the fifth project meeting as foreseen in our work plan. This meeting is the second time in the life of our project, that we can get another insight into Hungary. Győr is a mellow and colourful town situated half way between Vienna and Budapest, and hosts a vast array of architectural, cultural and natural treasures. The radial road network of the settlement connects Slovakia from the north, Austria from the west, Lake Balaton from the south and Budapest from the east to the town, the heart of Kisalföld (Little Plain). Győr, Hungary's second richest town in historic buildings outside Budapest has won Europe-award for the protection of the historic buildings, in acknowledgment of the reconstruction of the Baroque centre of the town. Churches, palaces, museums, characteristic corner-balconies and narrow lanes, all reminders of a historic past, invite visitors to take a walk in the centre of the town.

The University of West Hungary Apáczai Csere János Faculty originates in a school master-training course, opened July 1<sup>st</sup> 1778 and was the second one in historical Hungary to educate schoolmasters. The institution was called a College of Higher Education from 1975 onward. Its name changed to "Apáczai Csere János" in 1978. Győr has been a primary school teacher- training centre with a long tradition in Western Hungary. It has also taken a significant part in provided refresher and postgraduate courses for teachers. The name of the Faculty was taken from Apáczai Csere János (1625-1659) one of the leading pedagogical figures in Transsylvania – a follower of Decartes and Comenius (1592 – 1670). His main work is the Hungarian Encyclopaedia -the first ever printed encyclopaedia in Hungarian language (1639).

I am quite sure, that the Győr team will prepare another highlight of our TICKLE project and will welcome you very heartily in these lovely surroundings.
